USS MONTANA (SSN 794) Commissioning (June 25, 2022) Week Schedule for Montanans Norfolk, Virginia

*(Revised Schedule of 6/22/22 for all those attending from Montana,
and selected guests.)*

The overall plan for the USS MONTANA commissioning week in Norfolk, Virginia, remains generally as shown on previous preliminary commissioning week schedules. However, this likely final one reflects additional and updated information. Please review it carefully and perhaps keep it with you for easy reference. Its reminders and tips will help ensure that we have a meaningful and fun experience as we support our namesake warship and her sailors in Norfolk!

A logistics reminder: Naval Station Norfolk (NSN) event transportation will be from and to the Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel, 235 East Main Street in Norfolk. However, although our discounted room block there filled quickly, the hotels we listed in previous schedules (and that are shown at the end of this schedule) are all within a few blocks of the Norfolk Waterside Marriott, the Thursday evening get-acquainted event, the Friday morning optional harbor tour pier and Friday night reception.

In Norfolk you'll want to always wear your name badge that you'll pick up at our Waterside Marriott Hotel Information Desk. The desk is in the Start Lounge area on the second level at the top of the escalator. Adjacent to our desk will be the Navy's Will Call desk where you may pick up replacement or duplicate ticket that did not reach you by mail before you began travel to Norfolk. Our desk hours are shown by day. The Navy desk will be open Wednesday - Friday 1:00 to 6:00 PM.

In addition to wearing your name badge, it is also important to carry a government ID (such as driver's license or passport). And, as explained in a previous email and in a recent News page blog on our website, the Navy-required documentation of COVID vaccination or negative COVID test by an outside party within 72 hours of entering Naval Station Norfolk should be kept handy.

For Saturday's (6/25) official commissioning ceremony you must have your ticket that you received in the mail from the Navy or that you pick up at the Will Call desk explained above, along with your ID.

Please keep in mind that weather in Norfolk may be hot and humid. Rain showers are also possible, so you may want to pack a light rain jacket or small folding umbrella. Small unopened bottles of water may be carried onto the commissioning pier. Large umbrellas or bags, such as backpacks, will not be allowed on the pier. All events are rain or shine.

If in Norfolk you have a question, please check at our information desk, or ask one of our volunteers identified by their uniquely-red-banded name badges and/or red polo shirts.

This no-host event is a short walk from hotels. Participants will be able to meet one another and hear any program updates.

Casual attire is suggested, with comfortable rubber-soled shoes. No sandals or open-toed shoes please.

Be sure to carry government-issued ID such as driver's license or passport, and your COVID information.

7:45 AM Harbor Tour Cruise for those pre-registered

*The Harbor Tour Cruise includes Naval Station Norfolk and will be an amazing experience. Participants are, with a likely view from the water of the next day's Naval Station Norfolk USS MONTANA commissioning site. To sign up, go to:

The harbor tour pier is at the foot of Main Street, a short walk from the Waterside Marriott and other hotels. Just go toward the Nauticus Museum, then go left through the park where you will see the tour boat docked.

10:00 AM Meet at the park/Half Moone Cruise and Celebration Center drive adjacent to the harbor tour pier (see directions above) for transportation to Naval Station Norfolk tours.

10:15 AM Buses (USSMTC 1 & 2) depart for [Naval Station Norfolk base](#)

Norfolk has the largest naval complex in the world, home of the Atlantic Fleet, with aircraft carriers, destroyers, submarines, 18 Naval Aviation aircraft squadrons, and more.

SAFETY & COMFORT NOTE: Norfolk Naval Station and warship tours are designed to be wonderful learning experiences. They will allow us unique opportunities to see, hear about, and better understand both

technology and the dedication of those who use it in defense of our nation. But our principal concern is for your safety and comfort during a tour. So please be alert and follow crew instructions.

We ask that you wear comfortable casual clothes that will allow easy movement, including climbing of stairs or ladders. We also ask that you wear rubber-soled shoes with closed toes. No sandals or open toes, please.

Although most of our touring will be by bus or easy walk, going aboard a submarine can be a bit challenging. It has narrow passageways and small spaces - and the need to be physically able to climb down and pull oneself up vertical metal ladders. So, if you believe you'll be more comfortable staying topside, visiting with crew there and absorbing all there is to see around you, that is a perfectly fine decision that we would encourage.

12:45 PM USSMTC 1 Bus picks up these 54 and takes then to Vista Point for Lunch
Lunch is buffet style and costs \$15 per person

1:30 PM USSMTC 1 Bus takes these 54 folks on a 90-minute Naval Station Norfolk Base tour

3:00 PM USSMTC 1 Bus heads back to Norfolk Waterside Marriot

USSMTC 2 Bus (81 Passenger: Paul Babb leads on this bus.)

10:45 AM All people do a 90-minute Norfolk Naval Station Base

12:15 PM Drops all folks off for lunch at Vista Point.
Lunch is buffet style and costs \$15 per person

- 1:00 PM USSMTC 2 Bus takes all folks to Naval Station Pier 14
- One-half of group tours USS Montana
- One half of group tours USS MESA VERDE, the third SAN ANTONIO-Class amphibious transport dock ship
- 2:00 PM One half of group tours USS MONTANA
- One half of group tours USS MESA VERDE, the third SAN ANTONIO-Class amphibious transport dock ship
- 3:00 PM USSMTC Bus 2 picks all folks up at Pier 14 and takes them to Norfolk Waterside Marriott

All Montanans, as well as state and national officials, special Tribal representatives and others are invited.

The program portion of the evening will showcase Montana and her people. It will also include special presentations of gifts to the USS MONTANA from the Committee, from Montana Tribes, shipbuilders, contractors and others.

For today's events, all participants must have a government-issued ID (such as a driver's license or passport) and COVID documentation in their possession. A commissioning ticket provided by the Navy is also required.

7:15 AM Commissioning ceremony platform participants, officials and other invitees to a pre-ceremony breakfast briefing reception gather at Norfolk Waterside Marriott bus staging area for check-in.

Also gathering for check-in are Tribal commissioning ceremony participants, special public greeters, and ceremony volunteers.

Dress for Breakfast briefing reception: Business (jacket & tie)/Traditional

Dress for the commissioning ceremony is Business/Business Casual/Traditional

7:30 AM First bus (USSMTC 1) departs for Naval Station Norfolk (Stop 1: Pennsylvania House; Stop 2: Pier 14 commissioning venue)

7:45 AM General attendee staging at the Marriott Waterside Hotel for bus transportation to the Commissioning Ceremony

Breakfast is on your own, although coffee, juice and rolls will be Available.

Those needing to go to the airport for afternoon flights should bring luggage to the Marriott Waterside Hotel for storing if they would like to take a bus to the airport, arriving at ORF around 1:00 PM. They should then take the first bus leaving the commissioning ceremony at its conclusion. A stop will be made to pick up luggage at the Marriott Waterside Hotel on the way to the airport.

8:15 AM Second bus (USSMTC 2) departs for Naval Station Norfolk's Pier 14

USSMTC 1 bus will have returned to be available to transport more Montanans to NNS as needed.

- 9:00 AM (approx) Pre-Commissioning Ceremony guest arrivals, seating and events
- Montanans select seats in ticketed priority area, welcome and mingle with other attendees, and experience pre-ceremony events, including a planned Native American inter-tribal flag song performed by Montana tribal members.*
- 10:00 AM U.S. Navy traditional formal Commissioning Ceremony and “bringing the ship to life”
- Pier 14
Naval Station Norfolk*
- Dress: Business/Business Casual/Traditional*
- 11:30 AM First bus (USSMTC 1) leaves Pier 14 for Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel
- This time is approximate, depending on concluding time of the commissioning ceremony. However, as soon as all airport-bound guests are aboard, a first bus (with USSMTC 1 sign) will depart for Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel luggage pickup and then the airport.*
- 11:50 AM (approx.) A second bus (USSMTC 2) will leave at approximately 11:50, or about twenty minutes later, allowing time for photos, restroom, etc. This bus will go only to the Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel.
- For those choosing to go to the airport on their own, or from other hotels, there is taxi and Uber-type service available. Your hotel concierge can assist with arrangements if necessary.*
